READING HEBREW 1

weekly, beginning September 12, 2010 at 11:00 am

Learn the alef-bet, and begin to read prayers in Hebrew!

Improve your reading fluency; learn some prayer vocabulary and a bit of Hebrew grammar.

BIBLICAL HEBREW

weekly, beginning September 12, 2010

Learn the fundamentals for *translating* Hebrew in the torah and the prayer book! Before long, you will start understanding the Hebrew you read in prayer and in the weekly torah portion. How neat is that???. Temple Israel offers a two year introduction to this exciting subject. During the two years, students start the learning process and are prepared to continue this study as a group or individually. Learning to translate Hebrew in the torah/prayer book is a multiyear project.

Prerequisite: the ability to read Hebrew. If you need to improve your *reading* skills, get started by attending the Reading Hebrew 1 or 2 classes described above.
