**Micah Greenstein:** CCAR member; chair of CCAR Israel Committee; named by *Memphis Magazine* as one of the city's most significant leaders; Senior Rabbi at Temple Israel; Former President of Memphis Ministers Association; board member of the National Civil Rights Museum; faculty member of Memphis Theological Seminary.

**Anat Hoffman:** Executive Director of the Israel Religious Action Center; served 14 years on the Jerusalem City Council; founding member of Women of the Wall and served on the boards of the Israel Women's Network, the Association for Civil Rights in Israel, and many other Israeli organizations for social change.

**Yossi Klein Halevi:** Writer for *The Jerusalem Report*, *The Jerusalem Post*, *Los Angeles Times*, *New York Times*, *Washington Post* and *The New Republic*; author of several books, including *At the Entrance to the Garden of Eden: A Jew's Search for God with Christians and Muslims in the Holy Land*.

**Aaron David Miller:** Public policy scholar at the Woodrow Wilson International Center for Scholars; served as a Middle East negotiator in Republican and Democratic administrations; author most recently of the cover story in the May/June issue of *Foreign Policy Magazine*, "The False Religion of Mideast Peace" and the new book *Can America Have Another Great President?* published by Bantam; recently returned from three weeks in Beirut, Damascus, Jerusalem and Ramallah.
