

# Temple Israel/URJ Henry S. Jacobs Camp CAMBERSHIP INCENTIVE PROGRAM



For the summer of 2009, the Union for Reform Judaism will sponsor a first-time Campership Incentive Program for member families of Temple Israel.

**Any first-time camper – regardless of financial need – attending any of Jacobs Camp’s three-week-or-longer sessions – is eligible to receive a first-time camp grant in the amount of \$1000.**

*A first-time camper is defined as any camper who is attending a non-profit Jewish overnight camp for the first time for a three-week or longer session. Children who have participated in a shorter program (e.g., Jacobs Camp’s Olim Program) **are** eligible for this program. Children who attend a Jewish day school are **not** eligible.*

- ☆ Families wishing to participate should register their child for a session at Jacobs Camp and pay the \$200 non-refundable deposit.
- ☆ Families should then go to [www.onehappycamper.org](http://www.onehappycamper.org) to apply for the program. The grant amount will be paid directly to Jacobs Camp.
- ☆ Families receiving this grant who require additional financial assistance are still eligible for scholarship support through the Memphis Jewish Federation and Temple Israel. Call the Rabbis’ office, 761-3130, for more information on financial assistance.
