How can Jewish prayers and blessings be used for meditation, mindfulness, health, and creative inspiration? Using a number of paintings, artist Carol Buchman will do an art walk-and-talk, explaining how the imagery in these works are inspired Jewishly and then take on more personal meaning.

Carol Buchman, who grew up in Roslyn, Long Island, NY, received her BFA from the Massachusetts College of Art in Boston and an MFA from Boston University School for the Arts. She has been exhibited, commissioned, and collected privately and in museums, public spaces, schools, corporate offices, and synagogues. A piece was recently purchased by the Tennessee State Museum. Group and solo exhibitions of her work include the E.K. Rudin Museum Gallery in Great Neck, NY; the Alvin J. Fine Museum in San Francisco, CA; Columbia and Boston Universities; the Gotthelf and Platt Galleries in California; and Perry Nicole Fine Art in Memphis. Her work was the cover art for the *Magazine of Conservative Judaism*, in which she was also interviewed. Other publications include features in *Parabola*, *Jewcy*, and *Sh'ma*. Carol lives in Memphis with her sculptor husband and two cats.
