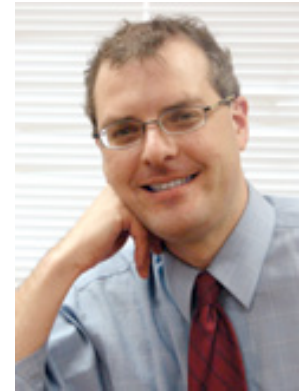




Temple Tuesdays
