

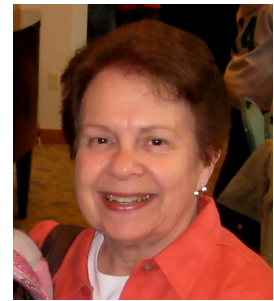


Temple Tuesdays
