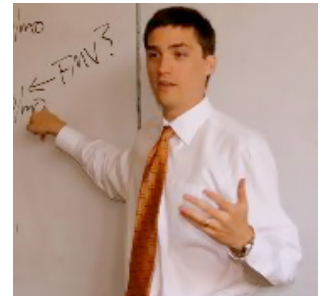




Temple Tuesdays

Professor Daniel Kiel will explore the controversial law of affirmative action in college admissions from a legal and moral perspective. Participants will discuss questions such as: What do the Constitution and Supreme Court say on the matter? How does the admission of Jewish students connect historically to modern affirmative action? And what is the proper balance in making admission decisions?

Daniel Kiel, a Professor at the University of Memphis Cecil C. Humphreys School of Law and graduate of Harvard Law School, teaches and writes on issues of race and education. His writing has appeared in the *Washington Post*, *USA Today*, *The Commercial Appeal* and several national law journals.
