YOU'VE GOT (E)MAIL!

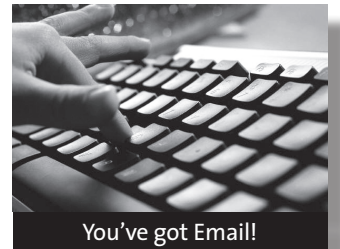
Users of AOL's email service hear the classic line "you've got mail" when receiving an email. While sending and receiving emails is obviously not new, Temple Israel is thrilled to announce to its members, "You've got *email!*"

Beginning next month, members' statements will be exclusively delivered via email.



"We're excited that we're now able to make this available to our members," said Temple Israel Executive Director Jeff Manis. "Last month's announcement regarding our members' new ability to access their account information online has ushered in a new way of interacting with Temple. (A reprint of that important announcement is included on page 4.) This is yet another high-profile example of taking advantage of an effective, efficient, and excellent opportunity."

"We're fortunate now to be able to provide this method of delivering statements to our members. By doing so, Temple will be more eco-friendly, and we will be good stewards of Temple's resources. Temple will also realize a significant reduction of expenses which sending paper statements through 'snail mail' incurred. The annual cost of using thousands upon thousands of envelopes, return envelopes, paper, and postage will be eliminated, as will the days and days of staff time needed to fold, stuff, handle, and process each statement every month."



You've got Email!

Two points are noteworthy: members who do not have an email address will continue to receive a printed statement delivered by the post office. Also, July statements will be delivered via email and, for one last time, via the post office.

"On a related note, we are more than happy to help customize members' payment options," Jeff said. "For example, a number of members already utilize the 'automatic bank withdrawal' option for payments on their annual commitment. If you'd like to take advantage of that opportunity, just let us know!"
