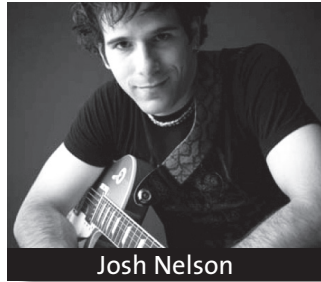
Delivering high-octane Jewish rock, *The Josh Nelson Project* is five of the most talented performers in the United States.

Each musician is young, Jewish, and a positive role model.

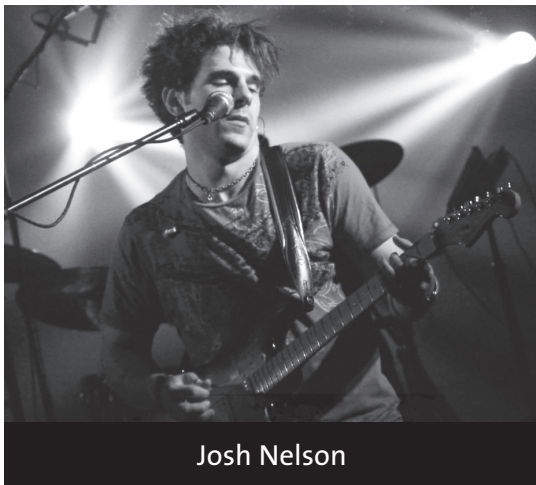
Currently, Josh is part of the music/lyrics team penning the score for the Broadway production of *Sleepless in Seattle*.

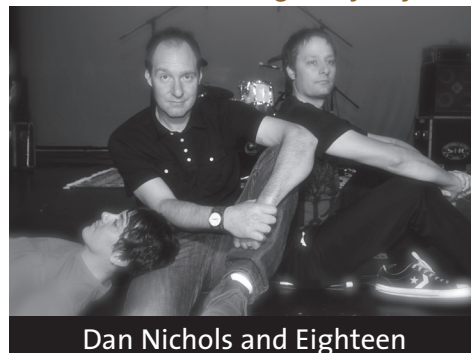
