### Overview of Position:

The Director of Youth Learning will be responsible for the implementation of educational programs and initiatives for all of Temple Israel's youth (K-12th grade), including Religious School, Hebrew School, and the Bar/Bat Mitzvah program.

### Roles and Responsibilities:

- Supervise and hire Religious School and Hebrew School teachers, as well as oversee the implementation of the Madrichim program for teen teaching assistants
- Develop curricula for all grades and programs
- Administer the school calendar, as well as coordinate the placement and utilization of clergy and specialists
- Interact on a personal level with families and meet their specific needs
- Strengthen the engagement level of Temple Israel teens and to bolster the quality and leadership of our teen youth programs
- Work with Henry S. Jacobs Camp's professional staff to develop strategies and programs to entice our members to support and/or attend HSJ
- Oversee the educational programming during the summer, as a senior staff person, at Henry S. Jacobs Camp
